Job Description and Key Responsibilities:

- Responsible for procurement, storage, and documentation of materials according to production needs, working closely with production managers to understand requests and targets
- Manage network of vendors, distributors, service providers and sub-contractors to meet quality, service, delivery, cost, risk mitigation and vendor capabilities
- Implement and negotiate vendor agreements to protect the company's interests
- Manage and communicate with Purchasing, Shipping, and Receiving Personnel
- Storage management for all inventory including housekeeping of storage areas
- Control of tracking system for shared tools and equipment throughout shop
- Minimize unnecessary stock of materials, consumables, etc.
- Responsible for return of defective or unwanted products, including credit negotiation
- Establish and monitor metrics to evaluate performance of overall supply chain
- Incorporate and support a culture of continuous improvement to increase efficiencies and reduce costs

Qualifications:

The candidate will have excellent organizational, communication, problem-solving, influencing, and time management skills.
